

# **TEAK**

COLLEGE MATRICULATION



### MIDDLE SCHOOL ACADEMY & HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT

After a competitive 6-month admission process, selected students are invited to join TEAK in the spring of 6th grade. Students then participate in a cycle of intensive programs to prepare for the selective admissions processes at top high schools, as well as for future academic success and personal growth.

### TEAK Admission [6th Grade]

Through outreach to middle schools and communities across New York City, academically talented, personally motivated, low-income students are encouraged to apply to TEAK.

# Spring Innovation and Summer Exploration [Spring & Summer / 6th Grade]

On Saturdays during the spring and for six full weeks in the summer, students build the academic foundation they need to advance within the Fellowship and school. Students refine their critical reading and writing skills in an analytical writing course, they are exposed to foreign language study, grammar, and vocabulary in a language course, and they develop their abilities to conduct research in a humanities course. Additionally, students attend a Leadership Skills Building Camping Trip and take part in Urban Expeditions.

### High School Foundations I [7th Grade]

Students continue their coursework after school and on Saturdays, twice per week, during the school year. Students resume humanities and writing courses, which now focus on research and writing through the art of documentary filmmaking. Additionally, students take a project-based math class and an introduction to Latin course.

### Summer Institute I & II [Summers / 7th & 8th Grade]

These six-week, full-day, rigorous academic programs offer intensive math, English, Latin, science, and humanities classes, as well as courses in art, drama, and dance. Field trips, a guest speaker series, and high school admissions test preparation are also included.

### Mentor Program [7th–12th Grade]

Each student is matched with an adult professional who volunteers to mentor a student throughout his/her Fellowship. Mentors share their knowledge of academic and professional paths, offer exposure to new experiences, and are added advocates in each student's network.

## High School Foundations II [8th Grade]

These after-school sessions, twice per week, include test preparation for the SHSAT, SSAT, and TACHS, as well as writing and math courses to further develop students' skills in preparation for the rigors of high school.

# High School Placement [8th Grade]

TEAK guides each family through the high school admission and financial aid application processes. TEAK provides comprehensive support in each student's search for the best high school match and helps place students in selective public, parochial, and independent day and boarding schools. TEAK does not assign students to schools nor guarantee that students will be accepted at specific schools.



### **HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS**

TEAK provides 4 years of comprehensive programs and services to support students in competitive academic environments and to prepare them for admission and success at selective colleges.

#### Check-Ins, High School Visits & Fellows' Forums [9th–12th Grade]

TEAK Deans are in regular communication with students through email, phone, and school visits. TEAK sets high academic standards for students and monitors school progress and grade reports. Students also attend Fellows' Forums at TEAK to share their experiences with a strong peer network, strengthen critical thinking and study skills, and participate in leadership development activities.

#### Specialized Tutoring At TEAK [9th–12th Grade]

This one-on-one tutoring program addresses academic challenges and helps students work toward subject and skill proficiency, future college admissions, and the transition to college-level work.

#### New York City History Course [Summer / 9th grade]

Enriching instruction further prepares students with necessary skills for advancement in high school including critical reading, note-taking, research, writing, and public speaking.

#### Public Interest Internships & Community Service [9th–12th Grade]

All students make a commitment to volunteer in Public Interest Internships at non-profits and to fulfill an additional 115 hours of service in their home or school communities during high school.

#### Summer Enrichment Experiences [Summers / 9th–12th Grade]

All students attend an outdoor leadership camping trip the summer after 9th grade. Students also have the opportunity to participate in study abroad, outdoor education, and pre-collegiate academic programs in subsequent summers.

#### Private Enterprise Internships [Summers / 11th & 12th Grade]

Eligible students participate in training in order to apply to and be hired for internships at host companies. The aim is for students to contribute to a company while developing professional skills and networks, exploring career interests, and earning money.



## **COLLEGE GUIDANCE & ALUMNI PROGRAM**

TEAK's comprehensive approach provides the educational foundation, academic guidance, financial aid counseling, and transitional support necessary for students to be prepared not only to apply to four-year colleges, but to earn a degree in five years or fewer.

### College Guidance [11th & 12th Grade]

TEAK provides comprehensive college guidance for students and families to supplement the resources offered by high schools. TEAK offers individualized college counseling, workshops on the application process, college essays, and financial aid, innovative SAT preparation, and college trips.

### Alumni Program [College & Beyond]

As students transition to college, they have access to a vast network of support coordinated through the Alumni Program. This program encompasses check-ins and visits for freshman; academic and financial aid counseling; an online community; and workshops and open houses. A Career Center sponsored by Société Générale equips Alumni with the tools necessary to obtain meaningful jobs during college and to embark successfully on professional tracks after graduation.

# MEASURES OF SUCCESS

In 2012, TEAK admitted Class Fourteen & Fifteen, Class Thirteen matriculated to high school, Class Nine matriculated to college, and TEAK celebrated its fifth year of college graduates. The Class of 2012 college graduates included a science teacher, an associate with the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, an engineer at Boeing, and a financial analyst at Time Inc. Postgraduate degrees in 2012 included a Master of Medical Science, a Master of Science in Business, and TEAK's first PharmD and MD. Since 2000, 100% of 8th-grade students have earned admission to academically selective high schools. Students have earned \$35 million in need-based high school financial aid packages that fund, on average, 96% of their total tuition costs. Since 2004, 100% of 12th-grade students have graduated from high school and have earned admission to four-year colleges and universities. Students have cumulatively earned \$26 million in need-based scholarships and financial aid for college. 100% of TEAK Alumni have matriculated to 4-year colleges – 87% of whom entered top tier schools, including 22% to the Ivy League. 86% of Alumni graduated or anticipate graduating from college in five years or fewer. 46% of Alumni gave back to TEAK with a financial or service contribution in 2012.



# CELEBRATING 10YEARS + COLLEGE GUIDANCE

College Guidance is a cornerstone program within the TEAK experience. Partnering with students' high schools, TEAK provides comprehensive counseling that is tailored to help students pursue their academic interests and achieve career goals. TEAK offers one-on-one essay and application guidance, standardized test preparation, and college trips. In addition, TEAK teaches families how to successfully secure financial aid packages that meet their need. The result of TEAK's 2-year college guidance process is students who are empowered with the tools and knowledge necessary for college success.

- 100% of 12th-grade students graduated from high school and have earned admission to 4-year colleges and universities.
- Students cumulatively earned \$26 million in needbased scholarships and financial aid for college.
- On average, TEAK financial aid packages covered 88% of college costs.
- 100% of TEAK Alumni matriculated to 4-year colleges 87% of whom entered top tier schools, including 22% to the Ivy League.
- 86% of Alumni graduate from college in five years or fewer.
- 30% of TEAK's college graduates have earned or are pursuing graduate degrees.

I'm a first-generation student. I'm the first person in my family to attend college. Matriculating to Cornell was definitely a victory for me and my family and a milestone in my life. Going to college has been my goal since the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. I have a great opportunity at Cornell, and I want to make the most of it. College is only the beginning!

Coming from a predominantly Hispanic middle school, going to Riverdale definitely opened up different perspectives for me. Riverdale challenged me to become a wellrounded individual early on. It was not an experience I could have gotten in my neighborhood public school.

TEAK helped me develop beyond my grades; the program encouraged my personal development. taught me how to let go of the fear of failure. It taught me not to be afraid of trying new things. TEAK taught me how to self-reflect and use every opportunity to better myself.

I think TEAK does more than just place students in high schools. TEAK's middle school programming ensures that students are well prepared academically to enter high schools with challenging curricula. TEAK does a really good job of promoting a sense of community amongst its Fellows so that TEAK Fellows serve as support to each other. It allows them to feel comfortable knowing that they are not alone. This type of support really prepares them for potentially challenging transitions to college.

I find that TEAK students are ready to tackle college courses and that they are eager to engage the Yale community when they are here.

And that is why we are delighted to be working with organizations such as TEAK.

I am the first person in my family to attend college so it means so much more to us. By helping me get into Spence and then Amherst, TEAK exposed me to so many classes that I wouldn't have been able to experience on my own. I can say with confidence that **TEAK opened many doors of opportunity** for me.

TEAK has influenced my academic and professional paths in many ways. The founder, Justine Stamen Arrillaga, showed us by example what it means to **set your sights on a goal** and to do what it takes to accomplish it. TEAK also instilled in me the importance of public service through internships and projects. This inspired my goal to become a civil rights lawyer so I can give back in my own way.

My graduation from Amherst and my matriculation to Columbia Law mean everything to me and my family. TEAK has influenced that decision for me. Just like TEAK has opened a world of opportunity for me, I want to **give back** in the same way and help people who have potential, but just need someone to open the door for them.





Contributions by Category Totaling \$2,148,434




CONTRIBUTION YOUR HOW **ALLOCATED?**
